Re: Compulsory use of the Eye Logbook

As from August 2011 all current ST1s were required to use the Eye Logbook to record their surgical experience and training.

The Eye Logbook has recently been updated to include a facility which enables easy entry of cumulative data about previous surgical experience. Straightforward instructions are provided on the opening page of the logbook. Many trainees at ST2 and above have already made use of this and are using this logbook.

In view of this the Training Committee has decided that:
All current ST2-5 trainees must use the Eye Logbook to record surgical experience and training from, at the latest, 6 August 2012 and at subsequent ARCPs. In other words as from 6 August 2012 the Eye Logbook will be compulsory for all trainees below ST7 level.
