To Whom it may concern,

We have recently been made aware of several cases from two centers in the UK of what appears to be a fibrinous membrane which has formed anterior to the CT Lucia intraocular lens after cataract surgery. In some cases, this membrane has affected vision. The membrane has dissipated or resolved with intense topical steroids or tPA injection.

Zeiss is intensely studying this issue, including the full scope of IOL testing and detailed analysis of clinical and surgical parameters. To date, no IOL associations have been observed. However, some cases have risk factors for a fibrinous anterior chamber reaction, such as intense postop uveitis and prior irradiation of the globe. The investigation is continuing with due haste.
