The Guide to OLT provides further guidance around all these areas and should be read prior to completion of this form. Programmes able to commit to all standards will be listed on the College website under a section created to support OLT programmes. It is essential that the additional training opportunities identified for OLT do not have any negative impact on current OST trainees.

Opportunity for all Curriculum requirements to be undertaken in the unit or alternative rotations facilitated to enable this

Recruitment follows values and requirements of OST recruitment

Ophthalmology induction undertaken in a timely way as appropriate to their previous experience

Evaluation of surgical skills of OLT trainees on appointment; where required enrolling OLT trainee on RCOphth introduction to Phacoemulsification course

Commitment to undertake relevant assessments; both WBAs and Clinical and Educational Supervisor reports 6 monthly

Portfolio: Paper portfolio completion until e-Portfolio available

Timetables designed to mirror OST training suitable for ST1-2 and ST3-7 as appropriate

Acute services supervision and training included in timetables

Generic Professional Capabilities (GPCs): opportunity and support to achieve as per OST curriculum requirements

Examinations: completion of suite of RCOphth examinations during the OLT programme with way points mirrored from OST curriculum

TSC opportunity: consider if appropriate

Consultant preparation should be given opportunity as OST curriculum

Simulation and surgical skills courses: availability as OST curriculum

Quality Assurance of OLT by Unit OLT Lead including trainee feedback surveys on the OLT programme

No impact on current OST training opportunities; all training for OLT being additional

Local 'ARCP' process i.e. Undertake local annual assessment process with panel as per OST ARCP, providing outcome and feedback

Trainees in difficulty offered pastoral support and remedial training as required
