ST4/5		Level 3 partly completed	<ul> <li>Complete <u>Level 3 transition schedule (including Community Ophthalmology and Urgent Eye</u> Care) - note that SIAs that are signed off by CS will be considered completed</li> </ul>
ST5		Level 4	<ul> <li>Complete Level 3 transition schedule (including Community Ophthalmology and Urgent Eye Care).
