ST3 	Level 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete transition checklists for Level 2 • Pass Refraction Certificate
ST4 	Level 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Get an Outcome 1 in your ARCP • Pass Refraction Certificate
ST4/5 	Level 3 partly completed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete Level 3 transition schedule (including Community Ophthalmology and Urgent Eye Care) - note that SIAs that are signed off by CS will be considered completed
ST5 	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete Level 3 transition schedule (including Community Ophthalmology and Urgent Eye Care). Nine SIAs should be signed off by CS and the remaining three (Community Ophthalmology, Urgent Eye Care, Cataract Surgery) reviewed in the transition schedule with checklists signed off • Complete Level 3 transition checklist for the six Generic Domains • Pass FRCOphth Part 2 exam
